CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

The Continued Education Requirements that will enable you to receive your 2011-2012 CNSM Private License are: Sixteen (16) contact hours per year (two (2) Continuing Education Units CEU's)

A contact hour is one hour spent in a learning or training environment under the direction or supervision of an expert. An expert is generally defined as a person who has advanced degrees in the area in which he or she lectures, teaches or trains. One CEU is equivalent to 8 contact hours.

Time that you spend teaching or lecturing others does not count as continuing education credit. The intent is for you to be learning new information, not passing the knowledge you have on to others

Your Licensing and Continuing Education year runs respectively from January 1st 2011 to January 1st 2012 or a year from the date your license was issued. We have been licensing each month to be able to provide better service. (CN^{SM's}) renewing their up to date license will be in the same yearly cycle as before.
